

## **Tips for Accessing 2001 Census Data on the ONS Website**

If you are looking for results from the 2001 Census in Lincolnshire try logging onto the Lincolnshire Research Observatory ([www.research-lincs.org.uk](http://www.research-lincs.org.uk)) and take a look at the 2001 Census reports in the 'quick links' menu to the right of the site homepage or try using the 'data and data mapping' wizard to search for mappable statistics. You can also type '2001 Census' into the keyword field of the 'full site search' facility to return a list of all available census data.

Although there are a wide range of census results on this site from national down to output area level, if you cannot find the information you require it is worth logging onto the Office for National Statistics (ONS) website [www.statistics.gov.uk](http://www.statistics.gov.uk) and using the guidelines below to search the their full database of 2001 Census results.

### **Accessing Key Statistics (for Local Authority Districts, Wards and Output Areas)**

1. Go to [www.statistics.gov.uk](http://www.statistics.gov.uk)
2. Select the 'neighbourhood' link from the top of the homepage
3. Select to 'search detailed statistics by subject'
4. Choose 'Census 2001' from the list of options available
5. Select 'key statistics' from the sub-menu
6. You will now see a list of census statistics by theme – double click on a theme of interest
7. Select the 'view' button adjacent to 'National down to output area East Midlands only' from the list of geographies that appear.
8. Select East Midlands
9. Select Lincolnshire
10. Select appropriate Districts to drill down to wards and output areas within them

***NB. To download a table of results for the East Midlands including all Counties, Districts, Wards and Output Areas select the 'download' button at step 7***

### **Accessing Key Statistics (for Parishes)**

1. Go to [www.statistics.gov.uk](http://www.statistics.gov.uk)
2. Select the 'neighbourhood' link from the top of the homepage
3. Select to 'search detailed statistics by area name'
4. Click the 'change' button at the top right hand corner of the page
5. Select 'ok' when the pop up message appears
6. Select '2003 Parish Areas' from the menu that appears
7. Select 'East Midland' from the next list

You will now be presented with a list of all Local Authority Districts that fall within the East Midlands Region. Selecting an LAD (by double clicking on the LAD name) will return a list of all parishes within that District. Please note that Lincoln LAD is not selectable as this is also classed as one parish so the results for

Lincoln District can be used in this instance. To find results for an individual parish.....

8. Select any parishes of interest using the tick boxes provided
9. Click on the 'Next' button in the bottom right-hand corner of the screen
10. Select '2001 Census' from the menu that appears
11. Select 'Key Statistics' from the sub-menu
12. Choose a theme of interest and use the buttons on the right of the screen to 'view' or 'download' this data for the parishes you have selected.

### **Accessing Standard Tables**

ONS have also released a number of standard tables, which cross-tabulate issues such as age and employment. These can be ordered from ONS through the following link:
