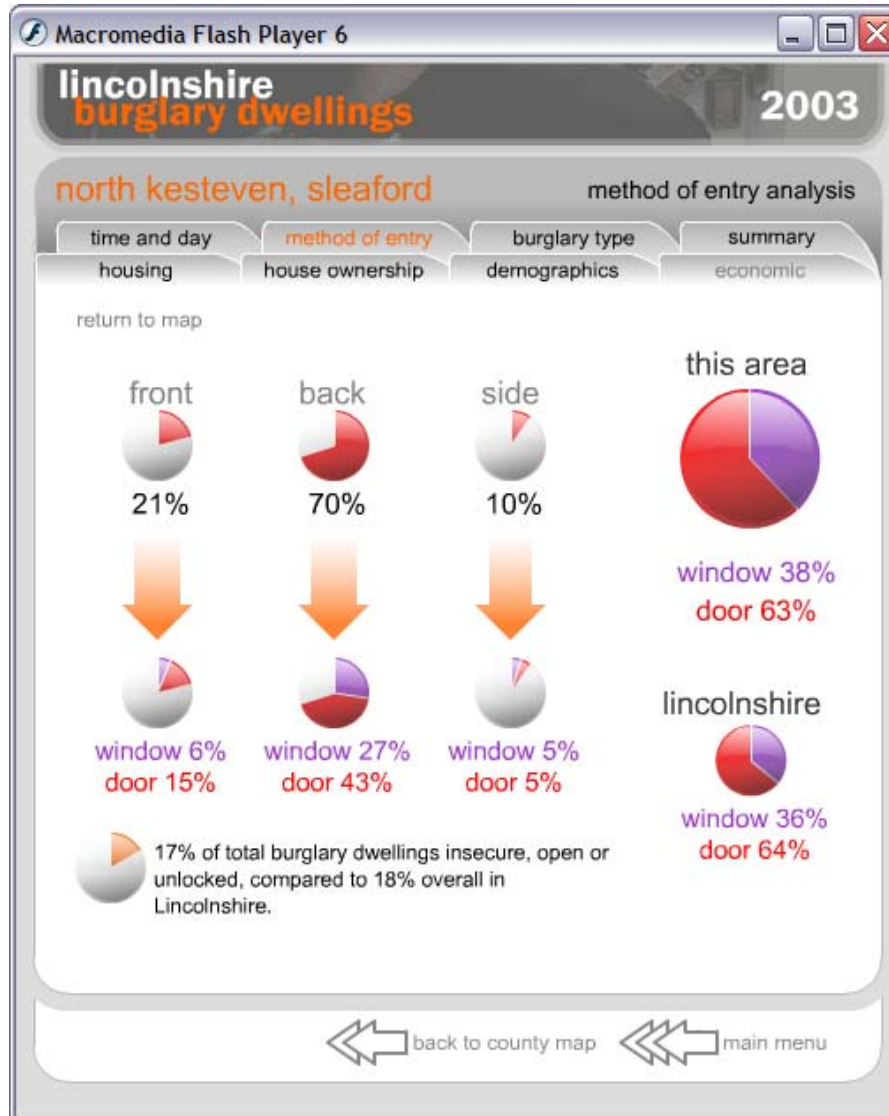

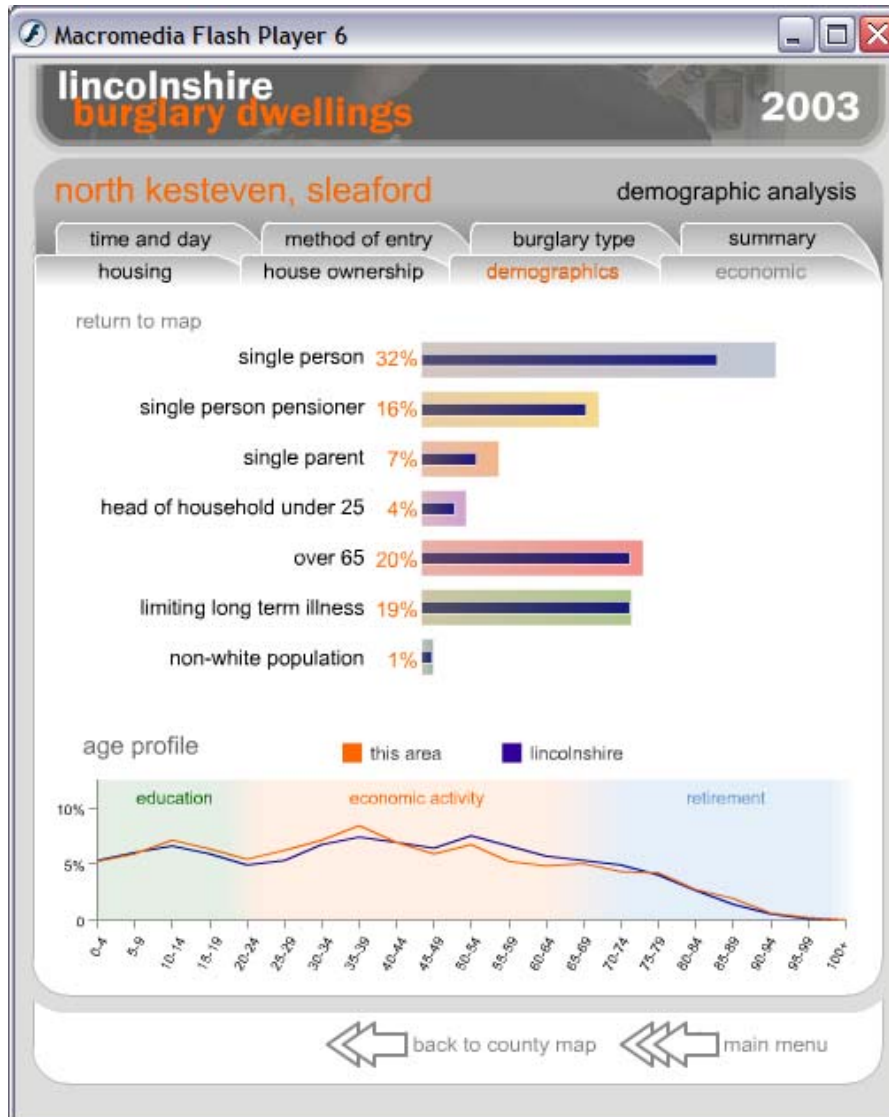

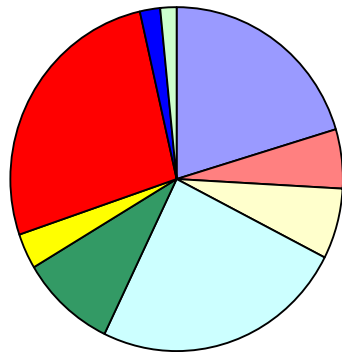
Crime and Disorder Audits

 - Develop strategies to deal with problems

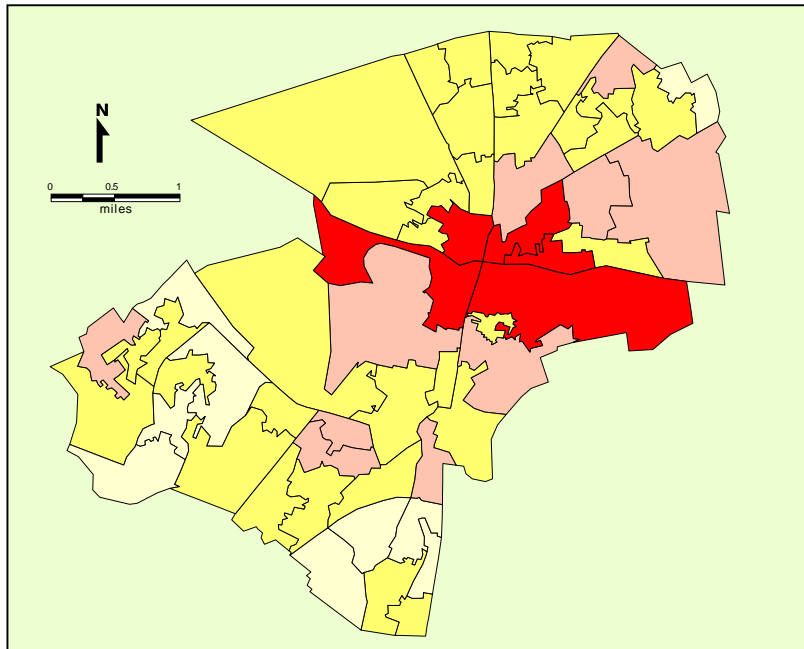
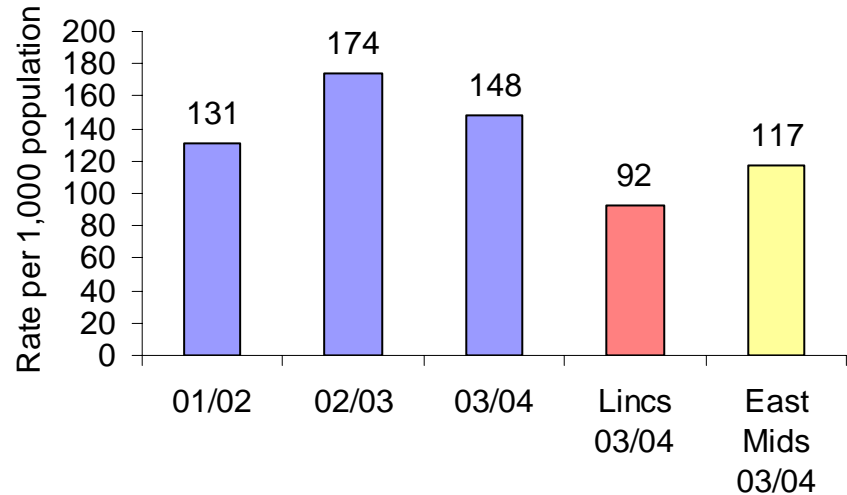
